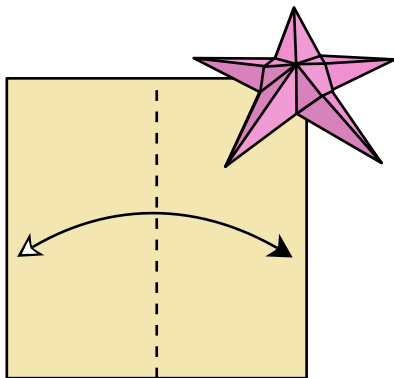


# Starfish and 18° construction

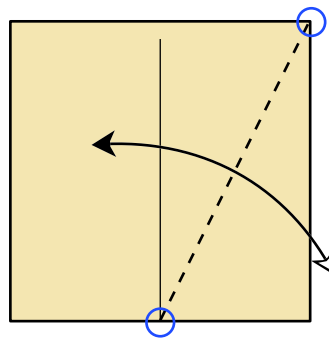


Exact version, adapted from *Easy Seaside Origami*.

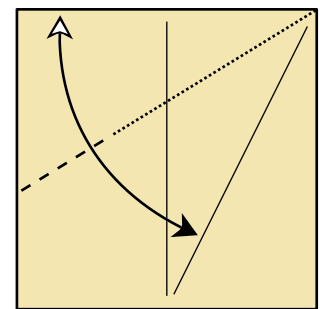

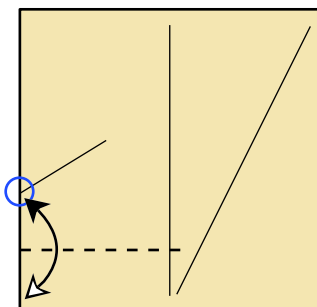
1. Fold in half and unfold.



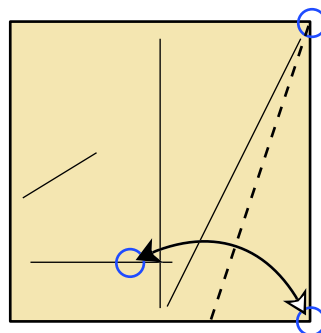
2. Make a fold which connects the intersections shown and unfold.



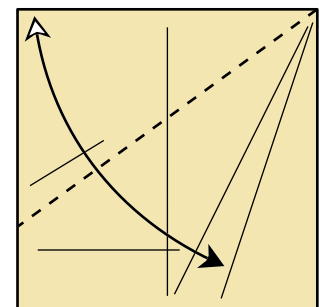
3. Fold the top raw edge to the crease you just made, only marking firmly at the left raw edge, then unfold.



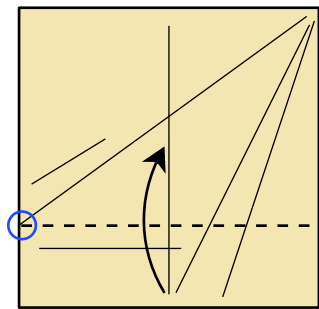
4. Fold the bottom edge to the intersection shown.



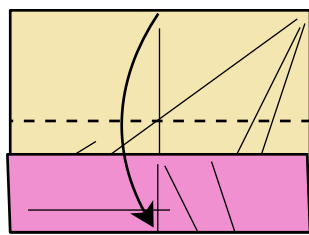
5. Fold the bottom right raw corner to the crease shown, so that the fold-line passes through the top right raw corner, then unfold.



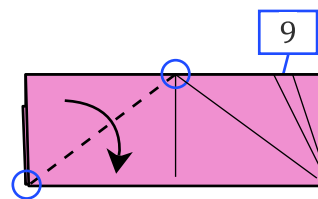
6. Fold the top raw edge to the crease you just made and unfold.



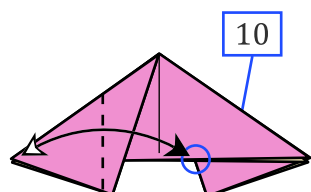
7. Fold the bottom edge up, so that the fold-line passes through the point shown.



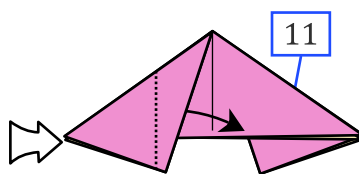
8. Fold the top raw edge down to the folded edge.



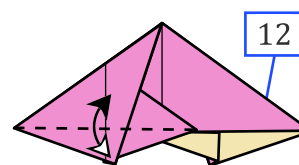
9. Make a valley fold that connects the intersections shown. Repeat behind.



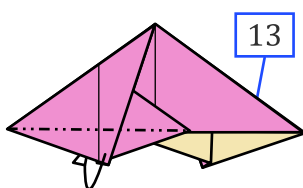
10. Fold the corners on the left to the intersection shown and unfold. Repeat behind.



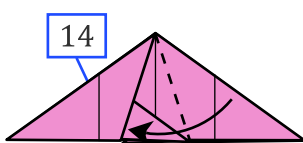
11. Inside-reverse-fold the inner corner only using the creases you just made. Repeat behind.



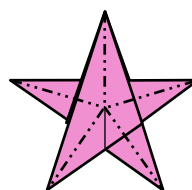
12. Fold a horizontal crease and unfold. Repeat behind.



13. Mountain-fold behind using the creases you just made, tucking the paper inside the pocket. Repeat behind.



14. Fold the top right edge to the folded edge shown. Repeat behind.



15. Pinch a line along the centre of each leg to give the starfish more volume.
